

Quick History...

- Kaua'i Electric (KE) was incorporated in 1905 as a subsidiary of McBryde Sugar in order to construct a 2.4 MW hydroelectric plant on the Wainiha River
- KE merged with Līhu'e Plantation's Waiahi Electric Company early in the 1950s
- KE became a division of Citizens Utilities Company in 1969
- KE was sold and formed as Kaua'i Island Utility Cooperative in November 2002


Solar was given low marks due to cost, manufacturing capabilities, and lack of storage technologies



















Where we started...
